Empower Yolo Peer Counseling Training

Empower Yolo is currently seeking volunteer and intern applicants for our upcoming state certified 65-hour domestic violence and sexual assault peer counseling training.

This is a comprehensive educational training; topics include types of domestic and sexual violence, the cycle of violence, effects of violence on children, child sexual abuse investigations, safety planning, working with law enforcement, Child Protective Services, District Attorney's Office and more. Volunteer opportunities include crisis line and legal advocacy, children's program; Russian, Latina, and API outreach; youth education and general community outreach and more.

Empower Yolo is also seeking **MFT/Social Work interns**.

The training will be held at Empower Yolo - 175 Walnut Street in Woodland, beginning Saturday, **April 24, 2017, through May 24, 2017**.

Training will be held Saturdays from 9am-5pm and Mondays & Wednesdays from 5:30pm-10pm. All training dates are mandatory.

Applications are due April 19th. Cost is \$50 for volunteers and \$100 for professional development.

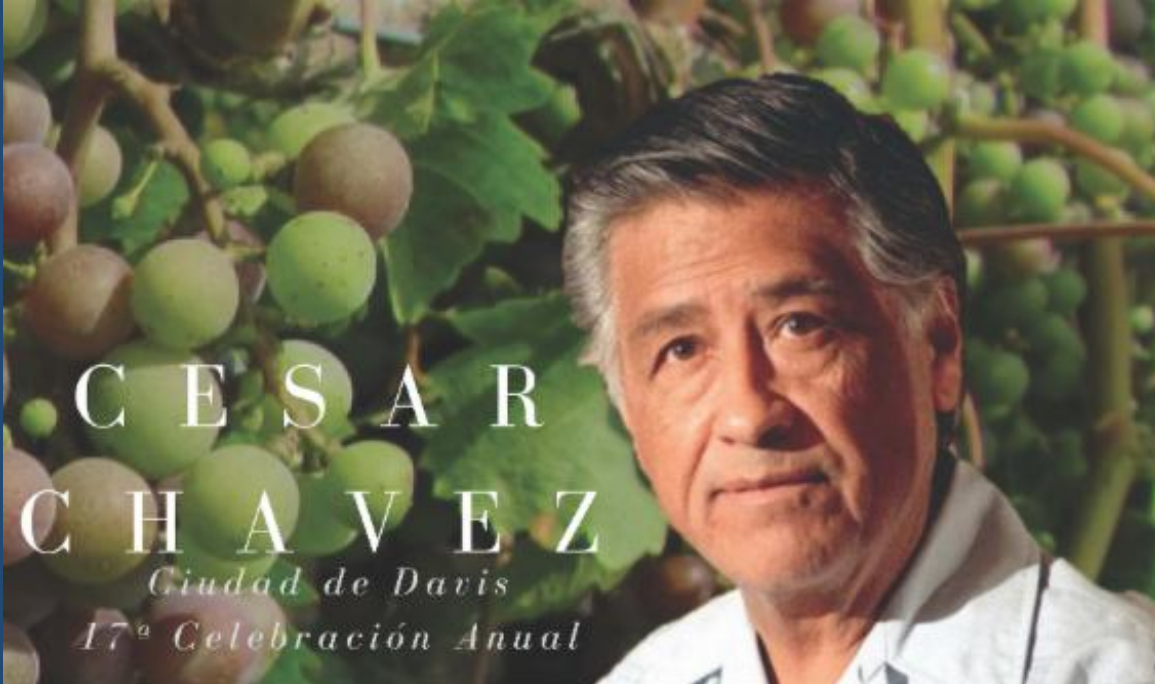

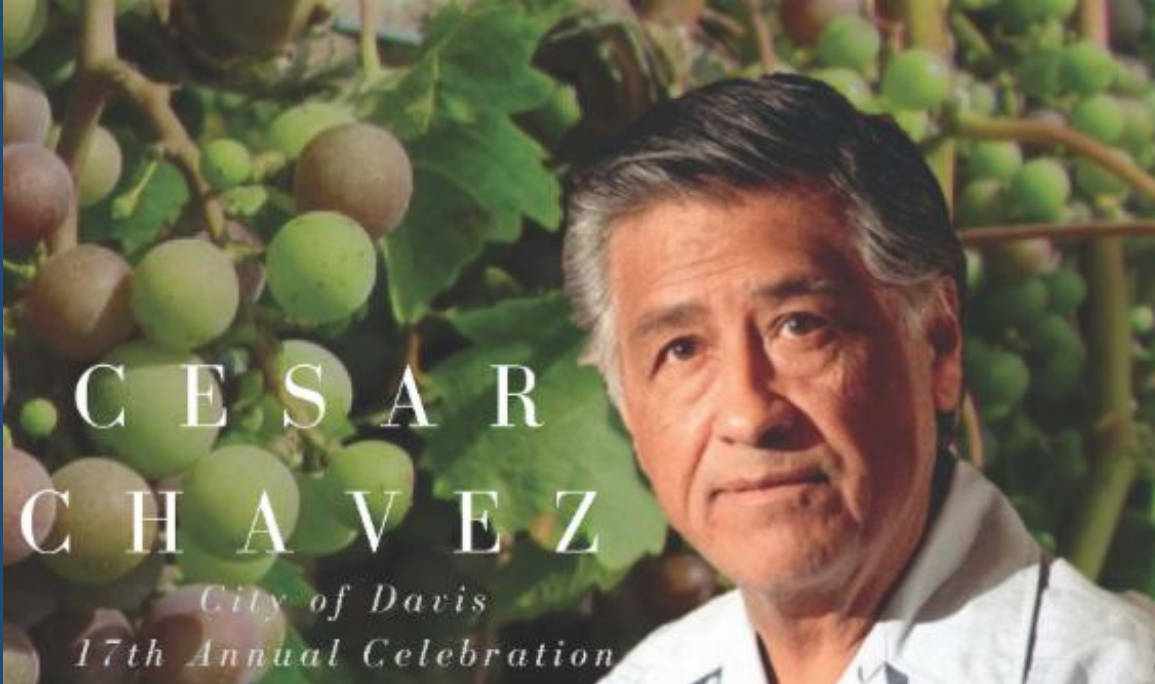
