Sexual Assault Awareness Advocacy Committee (SAAAC) ASUCD - National Sexual Assault Awareness Month

April is National Sexual Assault Awareness Month, and the Sexual Assault Awareness Advocacy Committee (SAAAC) ASUCD, in collaboration with other campus groups, is hosting a variety of events and workshops in regards to this important issue. As a part of this effort, we would like to invite members of Greek Life to collaborate with us in a Discussion of Gender Dynamics.

In the past, these discussions have been designed as a panel-style, small group discussion to educate people in the UC Davis community about sexual violence and gender dynamics. These discussions are unique because they are facilitated peer to peer, and include facts and information, but most importantly leave space for dialog within the group. We believe the discussions can be designed specifically for fraternities and sororities to start a dialogue about gender dynamics in Greek Life.

We have been discussing this program with Student Housing because we believe Greek Life may benefit from sexual assault trainings that are discussion based and personalized. These seminars, which have already been given to other groups, could be used as official trainings for Greek Life as early as next year. We would love to collaborate with you on the design of our discussions because we would like these discussions to be useful and help start productive conversations in your community. We believe that this will be an important opportunity for members of Greek life to have a voice in what you want to see from the required sexual assault trainings.

Please attend one of our two pilot discussions that will be held on **Tuesday April 11 at 6 pm** and **Tuesday April 18 at 6 pm** in the **Regan Main Hall in the Student Housing building**.
