The City of Davis wants your help to empower students in grades K-6th with the tools they need to ride their bikes to school and activities. We are seeking UC Davis fraternity and sorority members who like working with kids and want to help kids learn the rules of the road and how to ride their bike in traffic.

The City will host 5 Bike Rodeos in April and May at elementary schools in Davis. Bike Rodeos are a skills course that is designed to be fun, interactive, and non-competitive. We need volunteers to assist at our bike rodeos. Help kids with learning their hand signals, helmet fitting, stopping at Stop Signs and more.

The rodeos will be held from 1:15 - 3:00 p.m. on April 12, 19 & 26, May 3 & 10. The rodeo locations change each week. Interested in volunteering in 1 or all of the rodeos? You do not have to be a bike education expert, all you need is to like working with kids and have some bike skills. We will teach you the rest at a mandatory 1 hour training in March.
