Submit a Letter of Support! Room Reservation Fees for the 2017-2018 Academic Year

Review the following message from our council leaders on the room fee increase:

"For the 2017-18 school year, student organizations will have to start paying for room reservations for club related events or meetings. Based off current rates, these fees could range between \$10 - 45 per hour for all reservable rooms and classrooms on campus beginning July 1, 2017.

Student organizations have always had this fee waived in the past, subsidized by other university departments. Last year, Student Affairs committed to covering this charge but that commitment expired after one year. These room reservation fees will severely affect the success and very existence of the 800+ diverse student organizations on campus, which is what makes being a student at UC Davis so great.

We are asking all student organizations to join us in demanding that Student Affairs covers these fees, especially since we pay so much to the university already. Please see the attached email and adjust as you see fit in order to adapt it to your organization's goals and value on campus. Please send all emails to CSI Director Kristin Dees as soon as possible. NOTE: Kristen Dees is supportive of our cause. She will compile all emails to send to Student Affairs.
