Group Contest Rules and Information:

1. To enter as a "club/organization" the group must be a registered organization through UC Davis.
 2. Participants will check in for their group at the beginning of the drive at the designated table.
 3. Participants can donate under the group of their choice. They do not have to donate in a group they are affiliated with if they wish to support another group.
 4. Participants can only count their donation towards one group.
 5. If you cannot donate blood, volunteering will count as an entry in the competition.
 6. The winning group will be drawn based on the weighted drawing guidelines below.
 7. Checks will be made payable to the group name.
 8. If group members are found cheating and foul play is suspected, that group will automatically be disqualified.
- How the contest is weighted:

- 1-5 participants: One entry per participant
- 6-15 participants: Two entries per participant
- 16-25 participants: Three entries per participant
- 26-50 participants: Ten entries per participant
- 51+ participants: Twenty entries per participant
